Bringing History to Life

When commercial real estate developer Chuck Wiggin moved to Oklahoma City in 1978, he was captivated by the story of the city's birth, from the 1889 Land Run to the building of the city and its historical landmarks that exist today.

The series of historical markers brings Oklahoma City history to life, leading visitors on a walk through 28 historically significant sites in the heart of downtown.
