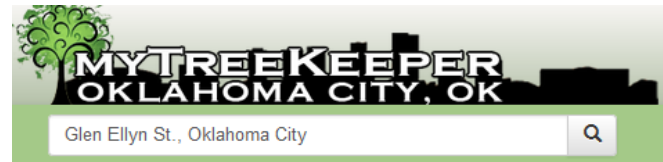


With MyTreeKeeper, you can identify all of the trees included in the Oklahoma City Parks Tree Inventory.

Below are tips to identify trees and parks using MyTreeKeeper at oklahomacityok.mytreekeeper.com

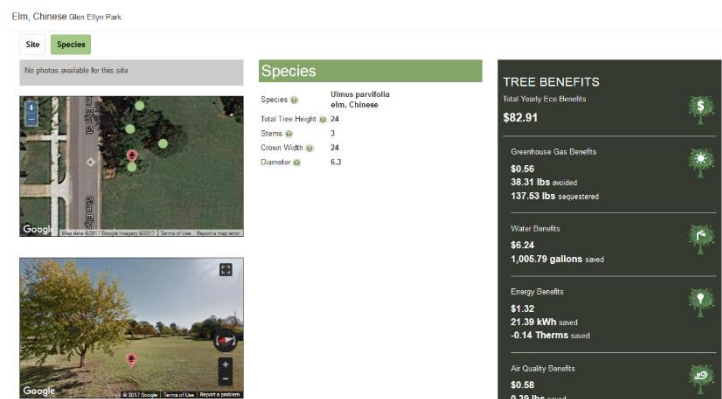
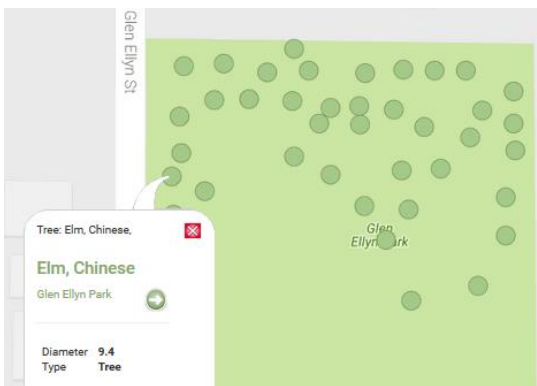
Search for a specific park

Enter the park address in the search bar in the upper left-hand portion of the screen.




View individual tree details

Click on an individual tree to identify the tree type. From the pop-up window, click on the green arrow to pull up specific tree details including photos, annual environmental benefits, presence of overhead utilities, species, total tree height, number of stems, crown width and diameter.



Other Options



Filters: Click  Ash Trees icon to view all inventoried ash trees.



Layers:

- Gold Medal Trees to view the top-performing trees
- Oklahoma City Trees to view all trees that were inventoried
- Google Satellite view
- Google Street view
